raises money for our Operation Family Help Program. This year we celebrated the festival's Tenth Anniversary! This year's event featured 42 teams, 900 paddlers and




thousands of spectators. The event promoted teambuilding by teaching the teams to work together for a common goal.

In 2016, we printed and mailed over 7,000 magazines to individuals and featured articles about quality, efficiency and affordability of healthcare.

The Paul Simon Award was instituted to honor Senator Simon's service to Signature Healthcare Foundation as a member of its board of directors. The program presents monetary awards to the individuals and institutions who have demonstrated, through a competitive review process, the most creative or effective method to save money and increase business efficiency in the healthcare system.
